

AAUW POLICIES (cont.)

MEMBERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES: All members are asked to participate in AAUW activities, including the Membership Tea, the money making projects, and hostessing for general meetings. If for any reason a member is unable to serve when her name appears on a committee, such a member will provide her own replacement.

STUDY GROUP MEMBERSHIP: It is an Association policy nationally that anyone holding a degree from an AAUW approved college or university must affiliate with the local branch in order to take part in the study group program. Study groups are "open" to noneligible women on a participation basis. A fee of \$3.00 will be charged. This one fee applies for interest or study groups.

TRANSFER MEMBERS: If a transfer member has paid dues to the branch from which she transferred, she shall not be required to pay additional Association dues for the current fiscal year.

HOLDIAY BAZAAR: Individual members must have prior approval by Ways and Means Chairman of proposed expenditures for cost of materials for Bazaar items for reimbursement to member.

CONTINUING ACTIVITIES of the Medford Branch include the following: CONTRIBUTING annual grants, named in honor of a member, to the National Fellowship Program.

AAUW POLICIES

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Members desiring to make announcements at meeting should first have them cleared by the board or the President.

CHILDREN'S PLAY: All funds received from this play must be added to the branch fellowship fund.

CONVENTION EXPENSES: Paid delegates to the state convention shall be the outgoing president and the incoming president or their alternates. It will be a policy to send as many officers or alternates as possible to conventions close to Medford.

COURTESY: The courtesy chairman will send get-well, sympathy, or congratulatory cards to members whenever these are appropriate. Plants, flowers, or other gifts are to be excluded.

DUES DEADLINE: Deadline for payment of dues shall be July 1. A check made payable to AAUW should be sent to the treasurer (\$12.50).

DUPLICATING MACHINE: Any AAUW member wishing to use the duplicating machine for non-AAUW use, may do so by paying a \$2.00 minimum fee or \$3.00/100 copies. This fee includes the use of the machine, Ditto, and paper.

FELLOWSHIP LUNCHEON: (Speaker): If at all possible, an AAUW Fellowship or International Grant holder should be engaged. If this is not possible, a foreign woman student studying at one of the nearby colleges should be secured as the speaker. (Reservations): Individual members who cancel a luncheon or dinner reservation after the reservations are closed are responsible for paying for the cost, if the organization is held responsible for these cancelled reservations.

FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS TO LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS It shall be the policy of our branch to generally refrain as a group from contribution to a project of any other organization. Requests of exceptional educational value may be brought to the attention of the board on an individual basis for consideration. The board in turn will bring any positive recommendations to the general meeting for action.
