

MEDFORD BRANCH MISSION ACTIVITIES

ANRW advances equity for women and girls through advocacy, education and research. The Medford Branch promotes the ANRW mission through the following projects:

Local Scholarships: The branch raises funds to assist women in Jackson County to further their education at Rogue Community College and Southern Oregon University. A scholarship selection committee reviews applications to select worthy recipients. Returning, older students, both of townships and out-of-town have benefited from these scholarships.

ANRW Funds: This is the primary ongoing arm of ANRW. Programs such as Fellowships and Grants, Legal Advocacy Fund, Campus Action Projects, National Conference for College Women Student Leaders (NCCWSL), research and many funds are supported. In particular:

The Legal Advocacy Fund (LAF) provides financial support for individual women seeking judicial redress for sex discrimination. LAF works in close partnership with pro-bono-acting attorneys that address significant discriminatory practices in the workplace, with the goal of eliminating them from all workplaces. The LAF Fundletter was a recent example.

Education and grants have been a core program of ANRW at the national level. The program awards over \$1.5 million per year in graduate fellowships and grants to women, and traditionally was called the Education Foundation (EF). The middle family of funds can be viewed at the ANRW Website (go to "Awards").

The Medford Branch established and continues to support 2 funds: The Margaret Buchanan International Fellowship Endowment of over \$100,000, which provides stipends for International Fellows, and the Seniors McGraw Memorial Fund, which was established to provide graduate project awards to US citizens.

Part of the proceeds from the District's Festival fund, funds and member contributions comprise the Branch's annual giving. Contributions may be designated to a particular fellowship or fund, such as the Endowment of McGraw funds, or any of the many women funds. Donations of \$25 or more may be designated as fellow or memorial to District and local uses. Members who become SENR become Century Club members and are honored at the Annual Scholarships/ANRW Funds Luncheon and at the state convention.

The newly formed Medford University Women Charitable Fund (MUMCF) is the fundraising arm of the ANRW Medford Branch. Designated as a public charity with 501 (c) (3) not-for-profit status in September 2015, MUMCF supports fundraising events throughout the year to raise funds for scholarships and educational resources of women and girls in the Rogue Valley. The MUMCF Board of Directors are members of the ANRW Medford Branch and are appointed for a two-year term to the MUMCF board by the Medford Branch Board of Directors.

Advancing Equity for Women and Girls: Membership in AAWP offers opportunities to learn about the issues and hot topics that affect equity for women and girls. Programs at quarterly lunch meetings emphasize business topics that address AAWP mission and vision. This translates to programs that inform and educate on subjects that impact the lives of women and girls. Examples include exploration of better resources, new school employees, change in social security, local community issues and other topics on educational and business benefits for women.

The Branch is an active partner with Regis Community College (RCC) for various related projects. In recent years the Branch assisted RCC with three special programs to educate high school girls and young women on challenges and strategies to achieve financial equity in the future. The Branch also supports the RCC student mentor program.

AAWP strives to have a public leader in advancing equity for women and girls, with informed and knowledgeable members.

The Medford Branch has historically had an active presence in the community. The Branch helped raise the library bond measure, worked for juvenile justice funds, assisted with local building training and assisted the West Medford Integration Site.
